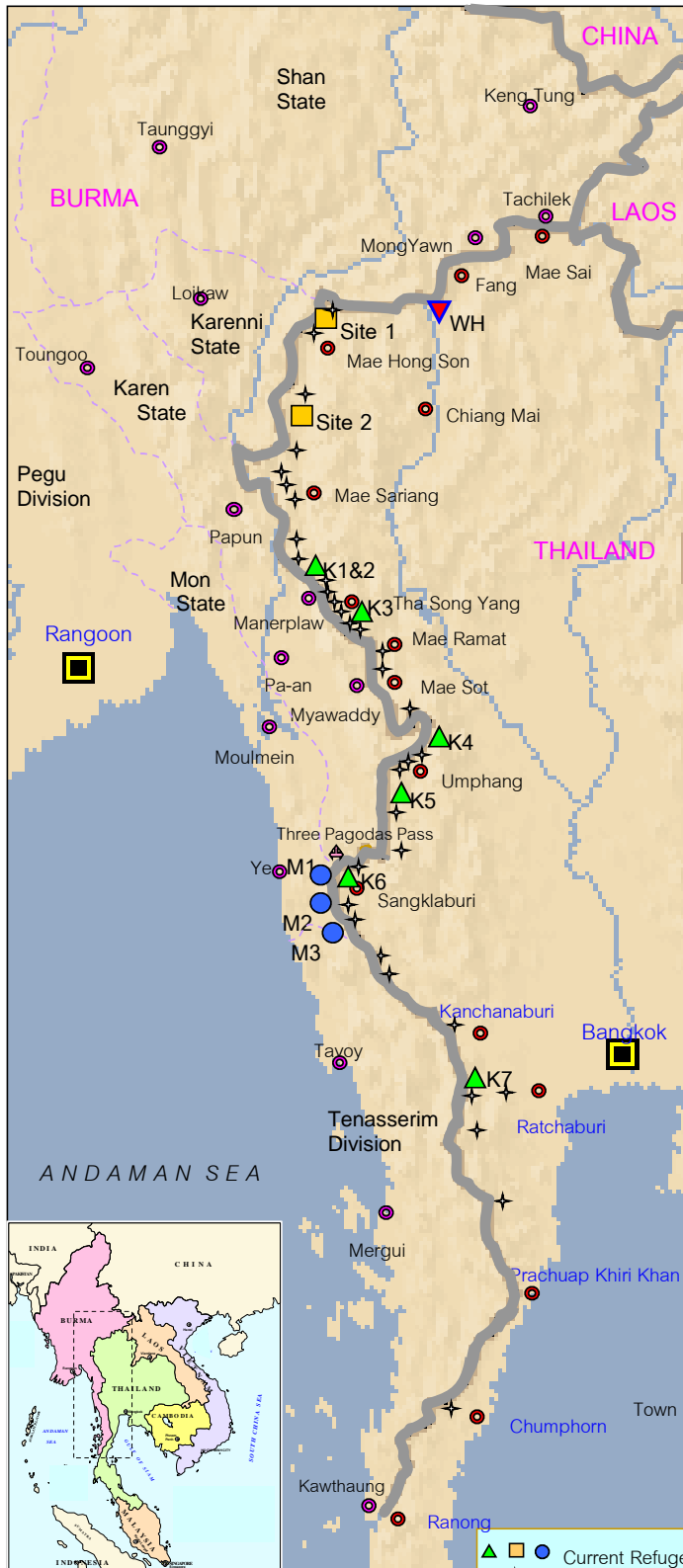
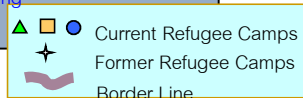


BURMESE BORDER REFUGEE SITES WITH POPULATION FIGURES - February 2005
