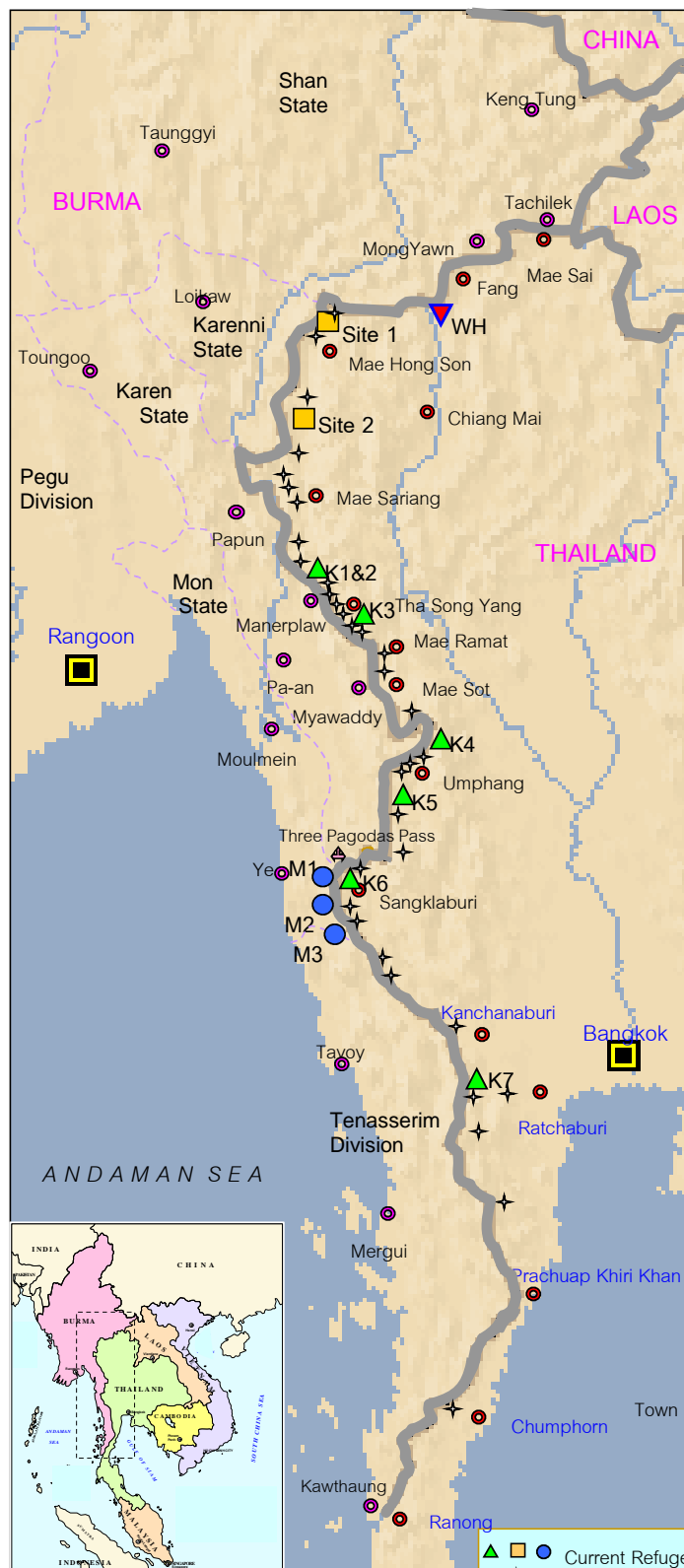
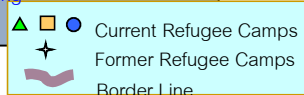


# BURMESE BORDER REFUGEE SITES WITH POPULATION FIGURES - January 2005
