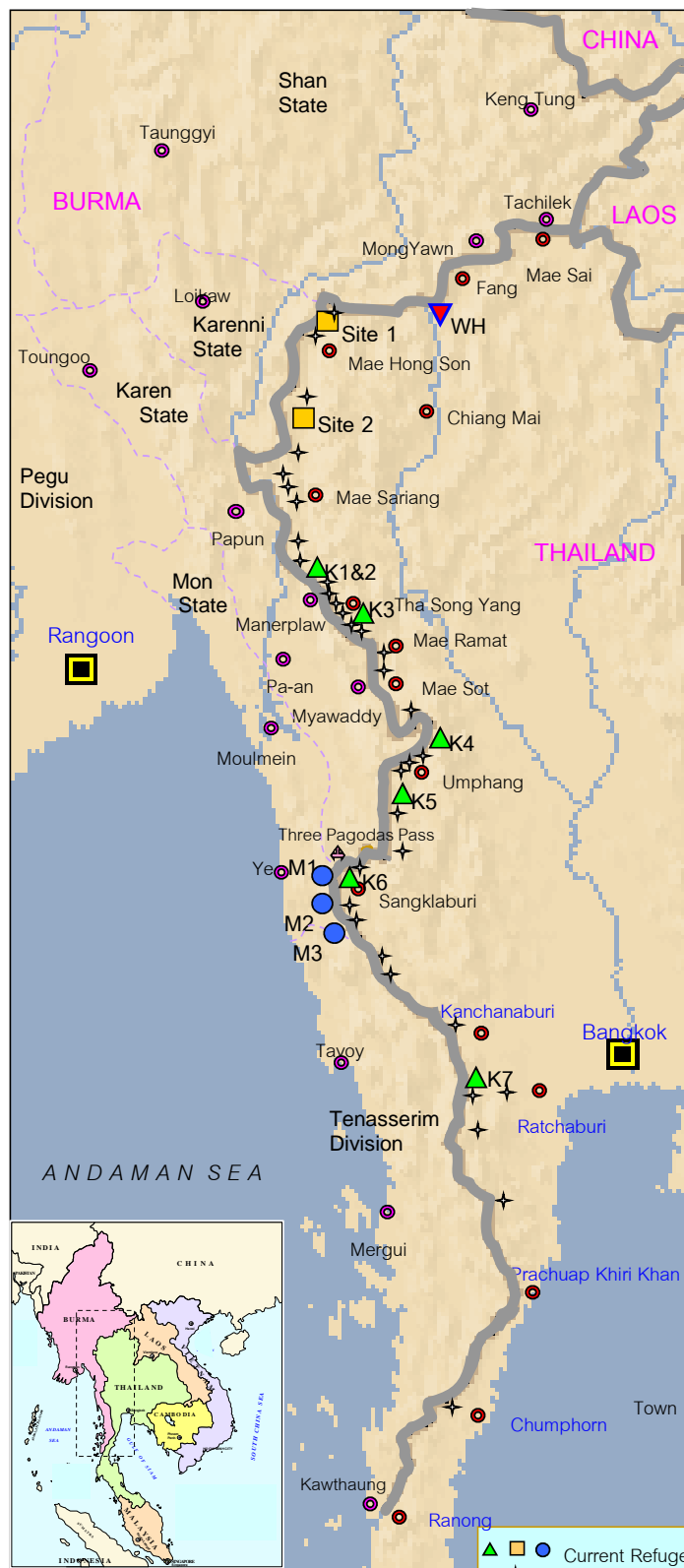
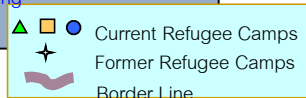


# BURMESE BORDER REFUGEE SITES WITH POPULATION FIGURES - December 2004
