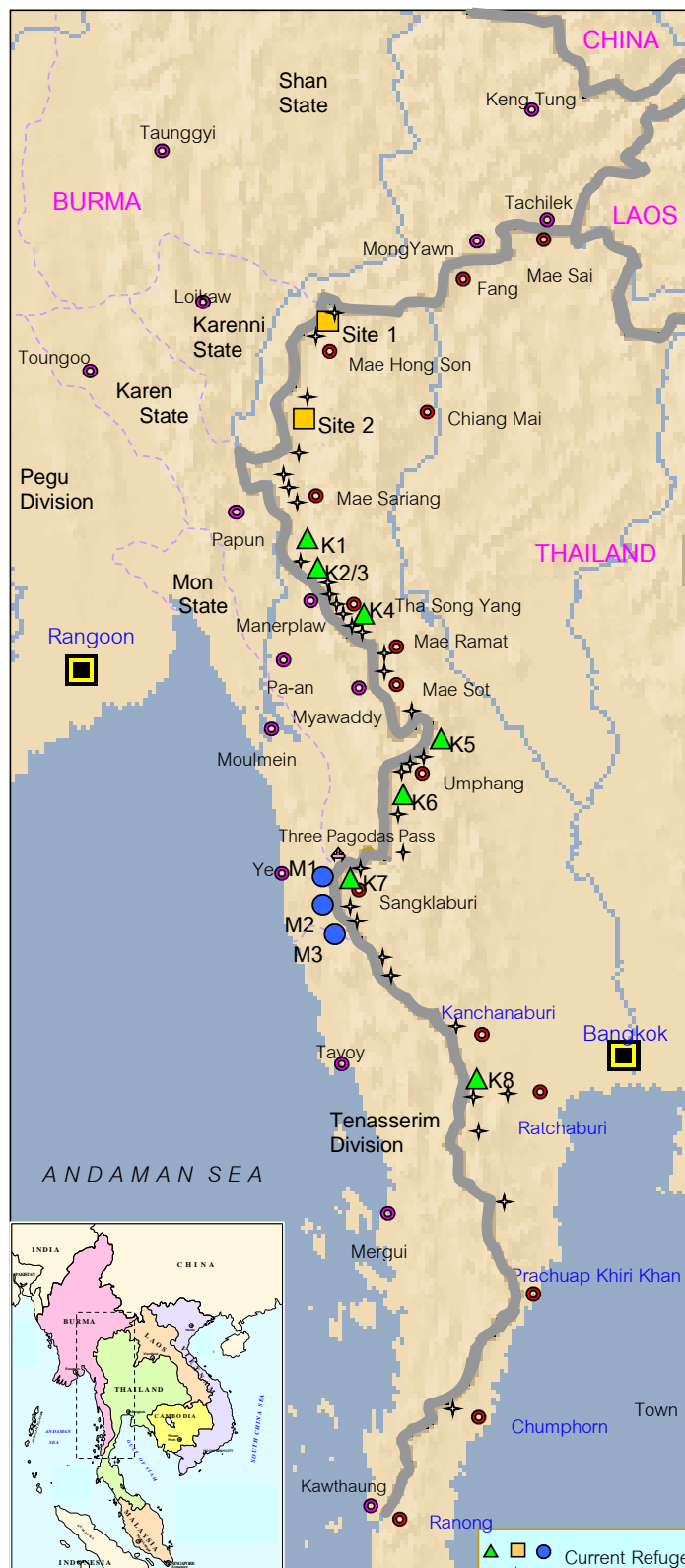


BURMESE BORDER REFUGEE SITES WITH POPULATION FIGURES - March 2004
