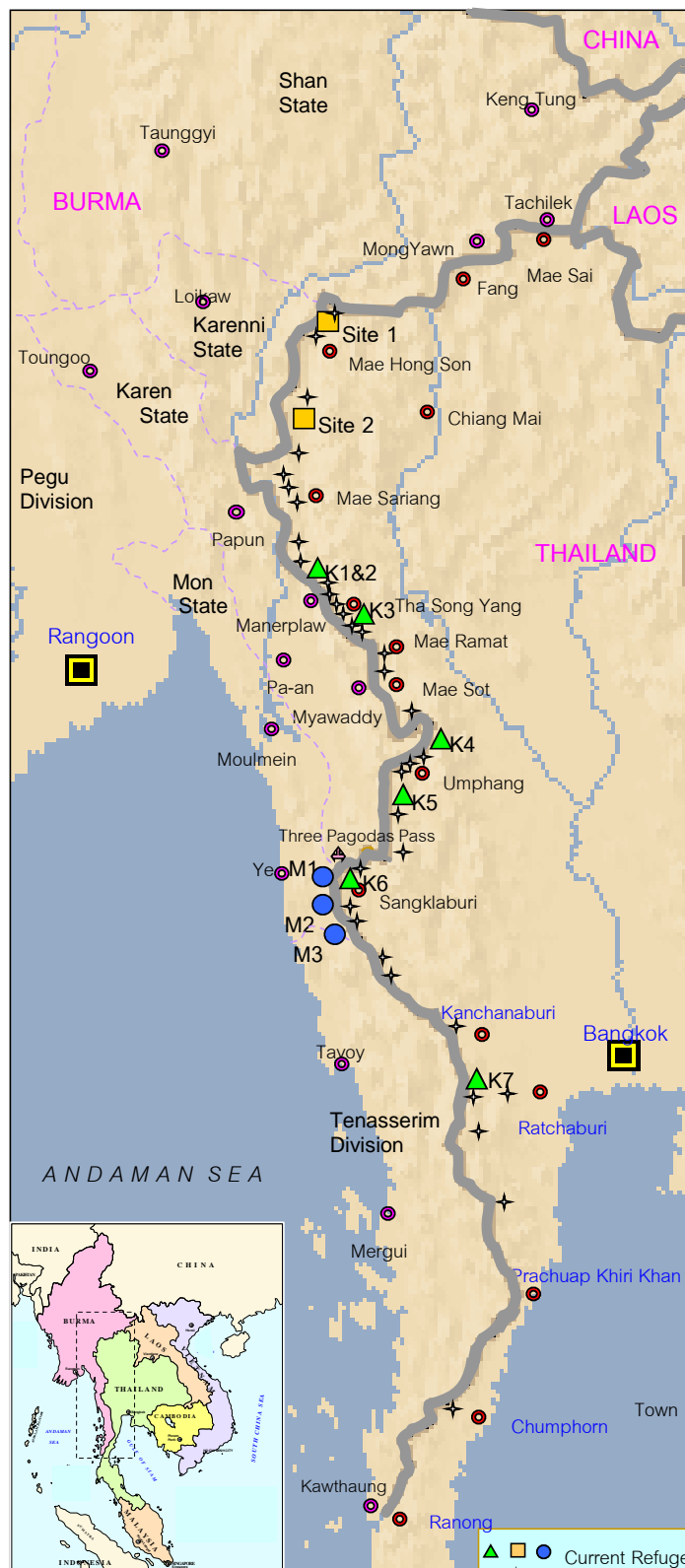


BURMESE BORDER REFUGEE SITES WITH POPULATION FIGURES - May 2004
